PAWS TIP:

Neonatal (newborn) kittens have folded ears, closed eyes and cannot walk.

They are fragile! Be extra careful.

PAWS TIP:

8 week old kittens must be at least 2 pounds before they can be spayed or neutered.

ARE THE KITTENS FRIENDLY?





Without mom, neonatal kittens need your help!

Neonatal kittens require round the clock care, attention and bottle feeding.



Let kittens stay with mom! She is their best chance at survival.

When the kittens are old enough, TNR, foster or adopt them.



Yes

Take the kittens to a veterinarian for a medical exam and to be spayed or neutered.

Then, find the kittens loving and safe homes.



At 12 weeks old. humanely trap the kittens for spay, neuter and vaccinations.

Return them to the same area or colony.
