PET PREPAREDNESS PLAN

In the event of an emergency, remain calm, informed and prepared. The calmer you are, the less stressed your pets will be!



WHAT GOES IN YOUR EMERGENCY PET BAG?

- Food, water and medicine for at least 3 days
- Medical records and information
- Collar with up-to-date ID tag, harness and leash
- Crate or pet carrier
- Familiar comfort items (toys, beds, blankets)
- Litter, litter box, and scoop
- Waste bags



TO DO CHECKLIST:

- Get pet emergency sign
- Choose an alternate caregiver
- Update microchip information and ID tags
- Assemble a pet emergency kit
- Plan for evacuation and find a pet friendly place to stay
