- All cats MUST be trapped in a humane live trap (approximately 3' x 1')
- Only ONE cat per trap.
- · All cats must be returned to their original colony/address after surgery.
- · Abandoning or relocating cats is ILLEGAL.

All cats will receive the following:

- Spay/Neuter surgery
- 1 year rabies vaccine
- 1 year FVRCP vaccine
- Mandatory left ear tip
- 1 month of topical flea/tick prevention applied
