

Community Cat Caregivers in Muscogee County

Paws Humane Society offers free spay/neuter surgery, rabies vaccine, FVRCP vaccine, and mandatory left ear tip for all unowned feral or friendly free-roaming cats in Muscogee County, GA.

Cats must meet the following criteria:

- The cat lives strictly outdoors
- The cat has no known owner (no microchip)
- The cat is at least 3 pounds or 12 weeks at the time of surgery
- All cats **MUST** be trapped in a humane live trap (approximately 3' x 1')
- **Only ONE cat per trap.**
- All cats must be returned to their original colony/address after surgery.
- **Abandoning or relocating cats is ILLEGAL.**



All cats will receive the following:

- Spay/Neuter surgery
- 1 year rabies vaccine
- 1 year FVRCP vaccine
- Mandatory left ear tip
- 1 month of topical flea/tick prevention applied
